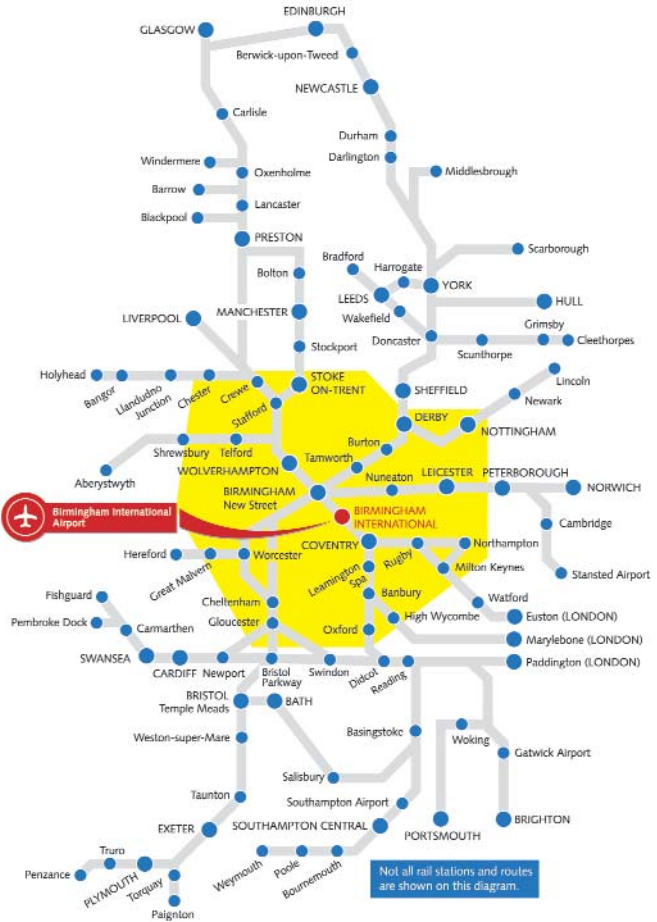

Principal Rail Connections to Birmingham International Airport



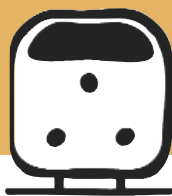
Air-Rail Link operates every 2 minutes between Birmingham International Interchange and the Airport Passenger Terminals, with a journey time of under 2 minutes.

Birmingham International Rail Station & Interchange



General Information

Birmingham International Rail Station & Interchange

Located only 500 metres from the Airport Passenger Terminals, Birmingham International Rail Station & Interchange is served by over 200 trains per day. Direct trains operate to many destinations including Birmingham City Centre, London and the South and the North of England.



Air-Rail Link takes you between the rail station and Passenger Terminals in less than two minutes. The free service operates approximately every two minutes. The **Air-Rail Link** station is at first floor level in Terminal 1 and only a short covered walk from Terminal 2. **Air-Rail Link** is open from 0515 to 0200.

No Direct Train Service?

Frequent direct services operate from most of the Midlands and many parts of the UK to Birmingham New Street Station. From there take one of the frequent trains (6 trains per hour during the day) to Birmingham International Rail Station & Interchange. The journey time is only 10-20 minutes - see pages 5-11 for train times between Birmingham New Street Station and Birmingham International Rail Station.

Link from Solihull Rail Station

Twice an hour the 966 Travel West Midlands bus will take you to the Airport from Solihull Railway Station connecting with Chiltern Railways services from Warwick, High Wycombe and London Marylebone Rail Station.

Going to the NEC?

The National Exhibition Centre is connected by a covered walkway to Birmingham International Rail Station & Interchange. From the Airport take **Air-Rail Link** to the Interchange. See pages 2-3 for a site plan.

Summary of Rail Services to Principal Destinations



This table is a guide to typical weekday train frequencies and journey times to major stations within the Airport's catchment area. Trains may be less frequent in the evenings and weekends.

Destinations marked '■' have frequent direct services from Birmingham International Station and journey times and frequencies are shown from that station.

Destinations marked '●' have infrequent direct services from Birmingham International station. Passengers may find it quicker to change to more frequent services at Birmingham New Street Station. Journey times and frequencies are shown from New Street Station.

Destinations marked '▲' have frequent direct services from Birmingham New Street Station and journey times and frequencies are shown from that station.

There are very frequent trains between Birmingham International and New Street stations with a journey time of 10-15 minutes.

Services from Solihull Rail Station

Bus 966 links the Airport with Solihull Rail Station to connect with Chiltern Railways' services to Warwick, Bicester, High Wycombe and stations to London Marylebone. This service also provides an alternative route to Leamington Spa and Banbury.

Services from Birmingham Moor Street and Snow Hill Stations

These stations are about 15-20 minutes walk from Birmingham New Street Station.

Saver Return tickets shown to Birmingham International Station may be used on any train, at any time of the day without restriction. Restrictions may apply on other tickets.
